With regards to your ongoing concerns about the behaviour of East Sussex County Council, I have now received a full response after writing to Keith Hinkley as you requested.


He has advised that the Adult Social Care dept. began working with you in October 2008, and have been providing direct payments continuously since this period, with this currently in place for three hours of care per week. He has also emphasised that you can contact ASC if your needs or circumstances change, and your direct payment budget will be reviewed.

He also reports that on 18/10/13 concerns for your safety were raised anonymously, and they responded by raising a safeguarding alert and raising enquiries with Sussex Police. After unsuccessfully attempting to contact you, a decision was taken on 28/10/13 to take no further action under safeguarding procedures.

A subsequent referral was made on 19/01/15 on your behalf reporting a physical attack had taken place. Again, this was dealt with through the appropriate safeguarding procedures, and a multi-agency response led by Sussex Police was put in place, and concluded with no further action on 14/04/18.

I am satisfied that Adult Social Care have complied with the appropriate safeguarding procedures and have met their duties towards you, as well as providing ongoing health and social care support, with a clear offer to review your needs if and when you feel these have changed. East Sussex Council have repeatedly addressed the allegations of elder abuse and neglect which you have raised, and my office will not support you in continuing to pursue these issues.
